Sofitel Los Angeles at Beverly Hills Achieves Savings from LA Green Lodging

SAVINGS

- Annual energy savings \$121,631
- Annual energy savings 868,793 KWh
- Annual water Savings \$49,500.00
- Annual water savings 9,375 HCF

ELECTRICITY

- Building exterior/landscaping/billboards are LED
- Guestrooms LED bulbs are A19 5W and MR16 3W (885-A19 and 590-MR16)
- Meeting rooms and public areas are MR16 and GU 10 LED
- Garage and parking are LED tubes
- Guestrooms HVAC are on occupancy sensors
- Back of the house lighting are all LED tubes and equipped with occupancy sensors
- Offices and storage are all LED tubes and equipped with occupancy sensors
- Meeting rooms and public areas HVAC and lighting are on EMS (Energy Management System)
- Major pumps and motors are equipped with VFD's (Variable Frequency Drives)
- Exit lights are all LED's
- Hotel has 12 EV charging stations used by guest and patrons for free
- Energy and utility consumption monitored and analyzed monthly

WATER

- 295 rooms with 1.5 gpm shower heads
- 295 rooms of 0.5 gpm lavatory faucets
- All public area bathrooms equipped with 0.5 gpf touchless urinals
- Annual water savings 9,375 HCF
- All public bathrooms are equipped with 0.5 gpf proximity faucet
- Kitchen faucets and pot washers are 1.5 gpm
- Removal of all single use plastic

FOOD & PRODUCTS MANAGEMENT INITIATIVES

- All cleaning products and detergents are Environmentally Preferable
- ORCA food waste recycling technology is in place, leading to zero food waste truck traffic on loading dock
- Electronics, light bulbs, batteries, glass bottles, plastic bottles, and metals are recycled
- Cardboard and paper are recycled on an average of 4500 lbs/month with savings of 30% on trash disposal
- Plants are native to our area and tolerant to local climate, drip irrigation is installed in all plant beds
- All paints used in the hotel are low VOC or Environmentally Preferable
- Sanitary paper products contain 10% - 40% postconsumer material
- Printing and writing papers contain 10% - 30% postconsumer material content

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- Hotel vendors must be environmentally responsible
- Hotel has linen and towel re-use program. Savings for this program goes to charity "Plant for the Planet"
- Hotel has installation of re-fill containers and re-fill stations, re-fillable shampoo and lotion bottles
- Partially used personal amenities (shampoo, gel, conditioner and lotion) are donated to the Global Soap Project, a charity that cleans these products for use in local homeless shelters, on average of 400 lbs/quarter
- Sofitel Los Angeles has signed ECPAT's Tourism Child-Protection Code of Conflict to help prevent the sexual exploitation of children
- Old mattresses are recycled and given to House of Hope, a charity that equips shelters with housing furniture
