ORCA

The City of Los Angeles Green Business Program (LAGBP) is a free and voluntary assistance program, launched in 2014, is aimed at increasing energy and water efficiency, generating cost-savings, reducing waste, and creating a healthier environment for Angelenos. Esterel Restaurant and Riviera 31 are certified since 2015. The Hotel is currently enrolled in a Food Waste Recycling Program with Athens Service to collect and compost all food materials and process them into nutrient rich compost for agricultural end users. Sofitel Los Angeles at Beverly Hills also owns an ORCA machine, that transforms organic food waste into liquid, avoiding accumulation of food waste laying to the landfills. The process also restricts collection of food waste made by trucks.
